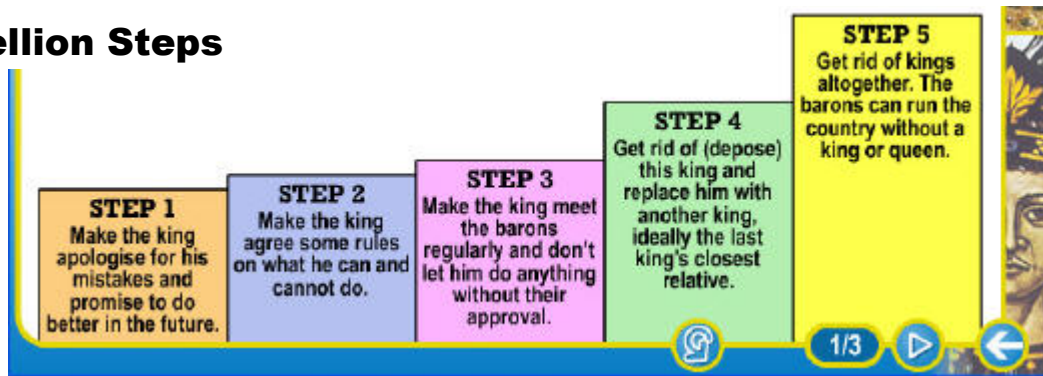
Did the barons ever get rid of the kings? 

REBELLION 1258 **Henry III (1216–1272)**
The barons rebelled against Henry III because he relied on a few advisers from abroad and did not ask his barons for advice. They forced Henry to hold regular meetings with them. These meetings were called parliaments.
